

The purpose of the Superintendent's Reading Award is to highlight and celebrate reading achievement (i.e., reading growth) among elementary school students. The students who demonstrate the highest growth on the MAP Growth Reading assessment from fall to winter and winter to spring will be recognized for their efforts. The top student(s) in each grade (Kindergarten through Grade 5) within Region 1, will be awarded. The Superintendent's Reading Award will take place in January and May.

We would like to remind families of our birthday treat policy as outlined in the Triggs Travel Guide (Student Handbook).




