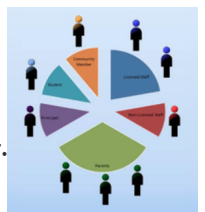


School Organizational Team (SOT)

DISTRICT SURVEY ON SCHOOL START TIMES FOR SY 26-27: YOUR INPUT IS NEEDED

Triggs Community,

The Clark County School District is considering an important change to the daily school calendar.

They are exploring shifting **all** school start times 30 minutes later, beginning in the 2026–2027 school year, because research shows that starting school later in the morning has significant benefits for adolescents. If this change is made, Triggs Elementary School will begin at 9:30 a.m. in the morning and end at 3:41 p.m. in the afternoon.

Before making this districtwide decision, CCSD wants to hear from every family about your thoughts on the proposal.

Your insights on whether there might be impacts on your family logistics, transportation, childcare, and work arrangements are important, too, as we consider this decision.
